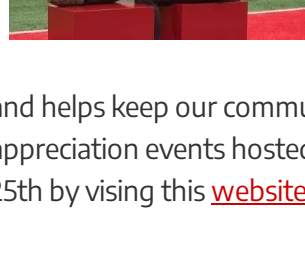
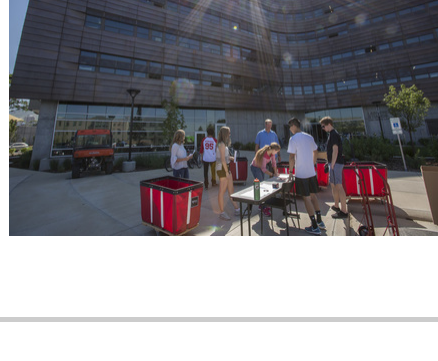

A Community Conversation: Anti-racism & Theories of Change

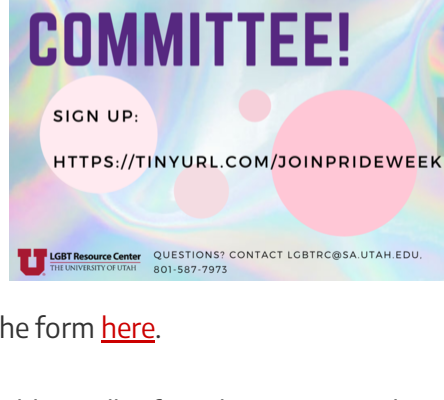
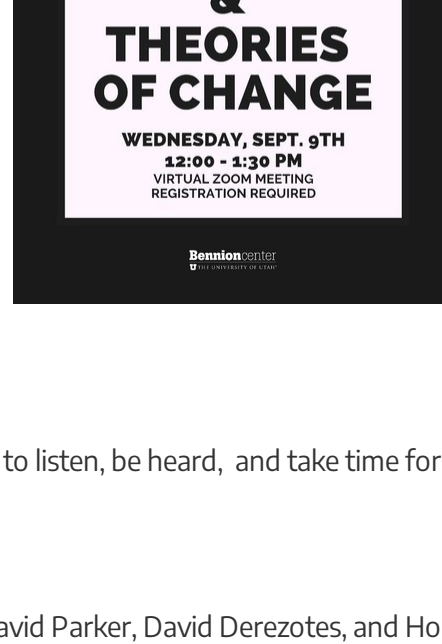
