Based on achievements in these areas, the awardee is selected by a committee of peers (Student Veterans at Utah association), with significant emphasis placed on service to the university and/or community. The honor consists of a \$500 scholarship, an engraved medallion, and the SVOY's name engraved on a plaque displayed in the VSC. Nominations are accepted from peers, faculty, and staff and should clearly explain in detail why the nominee's






