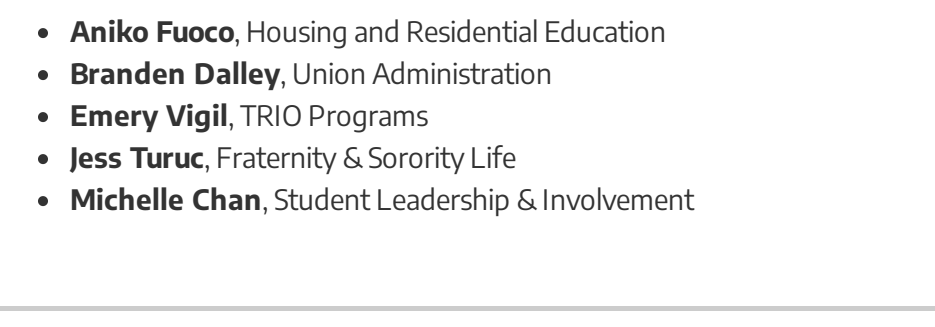

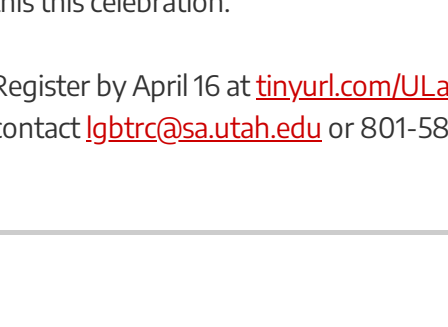

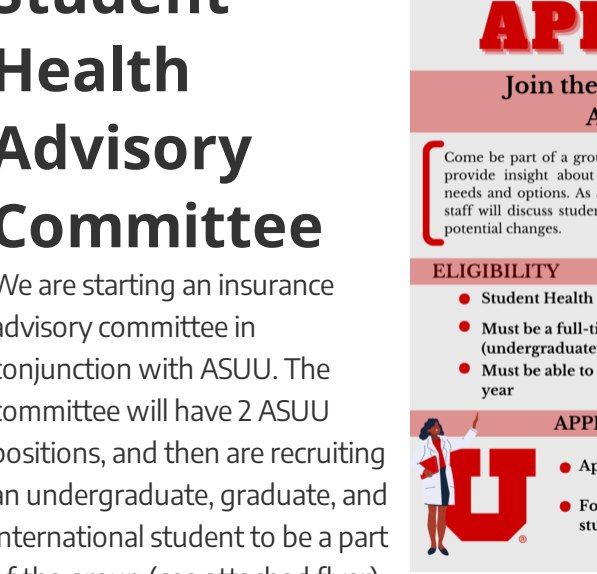
April is Sexual Assault Awareness Month

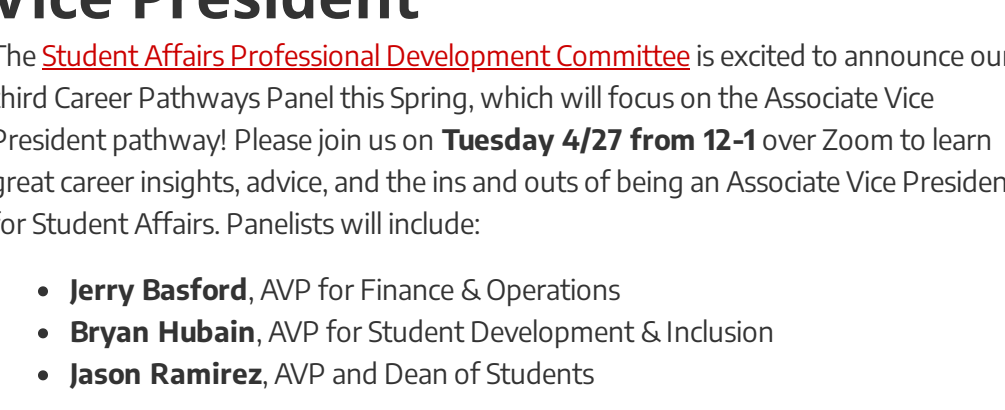

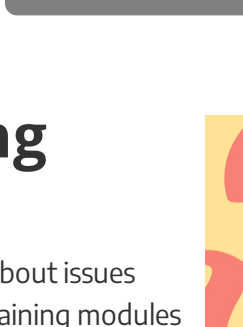

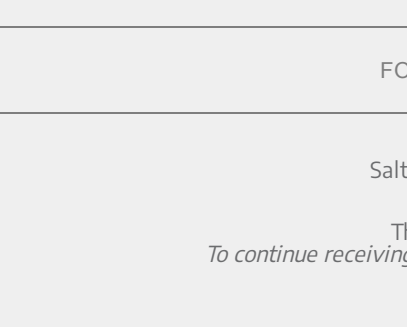
Financial Literacy Month
