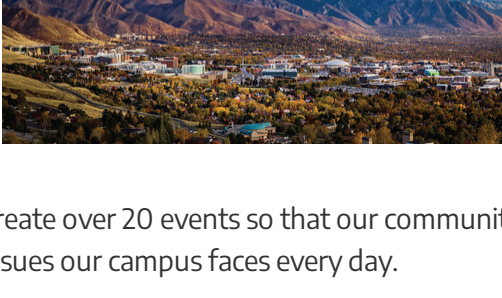
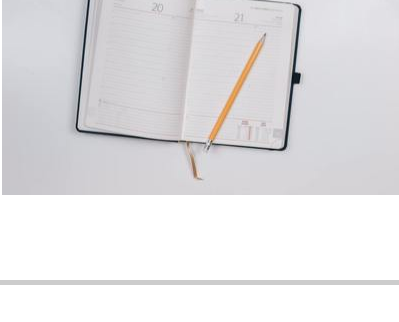

Day of Collective Action

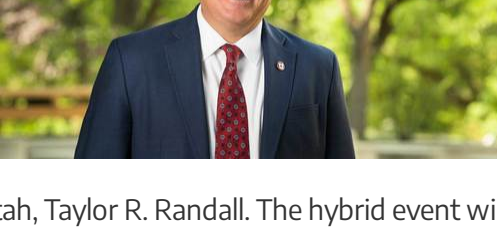

Bob Ross Paint-Along

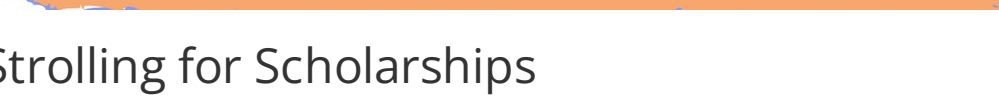
