# **Exit Evaluation Student Program Directors 2011-2012**

#### **Brief description of program / project:**

This survey was to learn more from student leaders at the Bennion Center, after their term. We wanted to have some quantitative and qualitative data from which to work to better identify how and where we need to improve. We thought there might even be the possibility of identifying some "best practices" and/or some patterns or trends that we might otherwise not be aware of.

## Who was asked to complete survey:

All of the volunteer student leaders who had a "program director" position sometime during the 2011-2012 academic year.

**Response Rate:** 57.5% (23 of 40)

## **Summary of Key Findings:**

- Issue Area of respondents: 10 Education and advocacy, 6 Environmental stewardship, 4 Health and ability, 3 International service, and 0 Social justice
- 74% of respondents agreed that they were provided adequate training to run a volunteer program
- Most important BC activities for respondents: Saturday Service Projects, University Service Coalition Events
- Least attended BC activities for respondents: Community Partner Forums, Service House Dialogues
- Respondents through that office hours would be best used by focusing on PD tasks and meeting with program volunteers
- All respondents agreed that they "gained leadership skills while serving as a Student Program Director at the Bennion Center!"

#### **Actions Taken:**

- Results were presented to Bennion Center stakeholders
- We need to improve and strengthen our "coordinator meetings" to make them more valuable and meaningful
- Our training program needs improvement and strengthening and, with the survey results, we have more concrete student input and feedback on how to best do so.
- Students are quite content with their service experience at the BC.
