Response Rate: 15.5% (29 of 187)

Summary of Key Findings: Pilot results show some variability among faculty in terms of awareness and knowledge of working with students with disabilities.

Actions Taken: Pilots results utilized for revisions and presented to Academic Senate Executive committee. Modified survey will be distributed in Fall 2011 to campus-wide faculty
