When asked about the reasons they chose to attend the U of U, students responded as follows:

80% Program reputation

19% Location

12% Cost

7% Friend/relative currently attends

7% Friend/relative is an alumnus/a.

7% Other

100% of respondents indicated they understood the basic immigration rules & regulations.

97% reported they understood the U of U's health insurance requirement for international students.

98% reported they knew how to contact campus police in case of emergency.

88% reported they knew where to go on campus for academic advising or academic help.

97% reported they gained useful information on campus resources and activities.

88% reported they were better prepared to study here at the U than prior to attending the orientation.

85% reported being more confident in their ability to succeed academically than prior to attending orientation.

78% reported being more confident in their ability to make friends and socialize with other students at the U than prior to attending orientation.

91% reported they now know what to expect from an American classroom.

98% of respondents reported the orientation registration process was smooth and efficient.

93% reported their Ambassador was helpful.

98% reported the International Center staff was friendly and knowledgeable.

All respondents reported that overall, orientation was helpful and worth their time.
