

Pride Week 2010 Evaluation

Brief description of program: Our annual Pride on campus included several events: four movies, a keynote speech and a lecture from Judith/Jack Halberstam, "Shades of Queer" (an open artistic performance night), an old-fashioned assembly, and a community panel on rights.

Who was asked to complete survey:

Students, faculty, staff, and community members who attended any of the above events.

Respondents: 218 people

Administration Type: paper & pencil, and entered by office into StudentVoice

Summary of Key Findings: Responses were very positive for such a large pool of participants. The movies, panels, and other events educated, challenged, and entertained people in different ways.

Actions Taken: We are currently planning the 2011 Pride with participant feedback in mind and involvement from members of the campus and broader community.

Which department and/or program goals does this survey align with?

- Raise awareness regarding lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender issues.
- Affirm lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender identities and lives by fostering a safe, inclusive, multicultural environment for the University's LGBT community.
- Support the academic mission of the University of Utah by promoting the inclusion of LGBT topics in the curriculum and other academic programs.
- Build linkages with other LGBT organizations and allied programs through outreach and community development efforts.
