Summary of Key Findings:

- Programs that were academic/resource-based in nature were received as assisting in articulating academic goals, finding pathways to goals, and understanding campus resources
- Respondents who participated in the Campus Life Mentors program through our office reported achieving learning outcomes at a higher rate than those who took part in other programs.
- All but one respondent plans to continue at the University in Fall 2014, with 75% planning to enroll as full-time students.
- Timing of workshops and other events worked well for the majority of respondents

Actions Taken:

- Number of workshops offered will be expanded, with hopes to make it easier for students to attend.
- Transfer Student Programs initiatives will be expanded to increase ease of access to resources and information.
