Who was asked to complete survey:

All students, transfer and first-year, who attended an Orientation for Summer 2011 semester. (Two programs only for Transfer students, three programs for both Transfer and First-Year students).

Response Rate: 93.1% (405 of 435)

Administration Type: link for website, iPod Touches

Summary of Key Findings:

63% of respondents did not register for classes by the end of Orientation.

Most common reasons are: Needed to meet with an academic advisor, wanted to consult parent/family/partner, work schedule, did not want to spend extra time at Orientation.

48% of respondents met with an academic advisor prior to Orientation.

80% of respondents plan to work 10 or more hours each week while in school.
