

Overnight, Outdoor, Two Day Orientations Fall 2012

Brief description of project:

Measuring satisfaction and self-reported learning of Orientation attendees.

Who was asked to complete survey:

All incoming first-year students who completed an Overnight, Outdoor, or Two Day Orientation for Fall 2012 semester.

How many people were asked? 2779 students (1334 respondents – 48% response rate)

Administration Type: Computer, iTouches

Summary of Key Findings:

Students generally reported satisfaction with all aspects of their orientation program. Students also reported understanding academic requirements and resources at a higher level than other aspects of the program, such as social, health, and involvement resources/expectations.

Actions Taken:

Results will be taken into account when planning orientation programs for future semesters.
