When asked about their future plans, students responded as follows:

41.81% plan to attend a 4 year college/university in Utah.

40.11% plan to attend a 4 year college/university out of state.

9.06% plan to attend a 2 year community college.

1.13% plan to pursue training at a technical/vocational college.

6.78% plan to take time off to work, then continue their education.

0.56% do not plan to continue their education beyond high school.

30.51% of respondents report they will apply to the U of U (49.15% Unsure).

19.77% Family obligations

37.85% Other
