96.60% of respondents agreed (Agree + Strongly Agree) the keynote speaker helped them understand the benefits of going to college.

94.60% agreed the student speaker helped them understand students' experiences at the University of Utah.

93.20% agreed this event helped them learn more about the different majors that are offered at the University of Utah.

97.26% agreed this event helped them to learn about the scholarship opportunities that are available at the University of Utah.

87.58% agreed they understand the admissions and financial aid process as a result of this event.

97.95% agreed that as a result of this event, they know about the different ways that the University of Utah provides support to multicultural students.

98.63% agreed they believe the University of Utah is committed to the success of multicultural students.
