Nominations are invited for the 27th annual *Vice President for Student Affairs Award for Service Excellence*. Up to three awards of \$500 will be conferred. The purpose of this award is to recognize those individuals who render exceptional service to students, faculty, staff, and others in the University community, thus contributing to Student Affairs' goal of excellence in service. We all know staff members who consistently go above and beyond what is expected of them. Now is the time to celebrate these people.

Eligibility: All full-time staff members with three or more years of service within Student Affairs, except Vice Presidents, Deans and Directors are eligible for nomination. Nominees should meet one or more of the criteria listed on the nomination form (past awardees have shown excellence in most or all of the categories). The Selection Committee can only consider information provided in the nominating and support letters, so be sure to be thorough in your description of nominee's qualifications.

The awards will be given at the holiday luncheon scheduled for Tuesday, December 13th for all Student Affairs full-time employees. Mark this date on your calendar and be with us to honor those who have been models of excellence for all of us.

Established in 1989, the <u>Vice President's Award for Service Excellence</u> acknowledges Student Affairs professionals who have shown superior service to the University community. The annual awards recognize outstanding people from Student Affairs agencies across the campus community. The award is not intended to recognize vice presidents, deans or directors.

Nomination Procedures:

- 1. Fill in nominee's information below
- 2. In 500 words or less (per question) submit a written statement addressing the questions on the following page
- 3. You may attach up to three letters of support

*Nominations not following these procedures will be accepted, but the award committee will only review the first 3 letters of support.

<u>Criteria for consideration</u>: Nominations must show how the nominee meets these criteria (most successful nominations address all of the criteria):

SERVICE:

- Demonstrates exceptional ability in quality of work, proficiency, initiative, skills in dealing with people, dependability, and creativity (quality of work as measured against the type of work being performed).
- Exhibits through personal qualities a high degree of the following:
 - Teamwork
 - Positive Attitude
 - Willingness to Cooperate
 - o Ability to relate to others (colleagues and students) in a manner that reflects well upon the University.
- Shows ongoing desire for improvement
- Has knowledge and understanding of the University and its functions
- Establishers and maintains effective working relationships/communication with co-workers, leadership, and internal/external customers

COMMITMENT:

- Service to the University demonstrates an attitude of ongoing commitment to assist the University in achieving its mission
- Contributions have long-lasting benefits to the individual and the University community
- Supports and participates in Departmental/University initiatives

Nominations may be made by any member of the University community (student, staff, or faculty), but are particularly invited from staff members of Student Affairs. All are encouraged to participate in recognizing qualified and deserving staff. All nominations will be considered individually, regardless of home department.
